Maynard & Lavina Dekryger Healthcare Scholarship

Criteria: 3.5 GPA or higher, Newaygo County high school senior, career in healthcare is anticipated

Amount: (Two year renewable) \$1000

Deadline: **March**

Mr. & Mrs. John Hathaway Scholarship

Criteria: 2.0 GPA or higher, will attend Montcalm Community College, recommended by the Tri County High School counselor or principal, Graduate of Tri County High School

Amount: \$500

Cheryl A. Pease Scholarship

Criteria: 3.0 GPA or higher, minimum of 4 varsity letters (Sports, Band, Academic, or Activities), attending a 4 year college or university, female senior at Tri County High School

Criteria: 2.5 GPA or higher, one varsity letter in wrestling, attending a 4 year college or university, outstanding citizenship, male senior at Tri County High School

Amount: \$250 - \$500
Deadline: **April**

Montcalm County Panhandle Chamber of Commerce Robert Alger Scholarship

Criteria: 3.0 GPA or higher, resident of Pierson, Reynolds, Winfield, or Maple Valley townships, Montcalm County, Senior, have demonstrated good citizenship in school and community, 250 word essay regarding career goals and plans for post-secondary education, list of school and community activities

Amount: \$500
Deadline: **April**

Spectrum Health United Memorial Scholarship

Criteria: 3.0 GPA or higher, a one page double-spaced essay outlining the students motivation for entering health care and describing professional goals, Tri County senior, admitted to a college or university and must be planning on a career in the health field

Amount: \$1000

Tri County Teachers Association Scholarship

Criteria: Tri County senior, essay that describes educational goals, career goals, and other information to help selection committee understand why you are the best candidate, GPA and school, community activities are also considered

Amount: \$500

Criteria: US citizen, academic achievement, good citizenship, participation in extracurricular activities, essay on why you are the best candidate for the scholarship, student at Tri County High School

Amount: \$1000.00

Criteria: 3.0 GPA, live in Montcalm County, essay on goals and why you should receive the scholarship, extra curricular activities
