# **Fill Out the FAFSA Night**



- For seniors and their parents, who need help filling out the FAFSA in order to be eligible for financial aid for college next year.
- Wednesday, February 8<sup>th</sup> from 7-8pm, in the high school media center with counselors, Mrs. Kik and Mrs. Renner.
- A representative from Montcalm Community College's Financial Aid Office will also be here to help answer any questions.
- We will have computers for you (student & parents) to use to complete the FAFSA, and we will be here to help answer questions you may have.
- What to bring:
  - Pin numbers (see [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov))
  - Student
  - Parents or legal guardians
  - Social Security numbers
  - Driver's licenses (if you have them)
  - W-2 forms or other records of money earned.
  - 2011 federal income tax returns
  - 2011 bank statements
  - 2011 business & investment mortgage info, business & farm records, stock, bond, & other investment records.
  - 2011 untaxed income records – social security, temp assistance to Needy Families, welfare, veteran benefit records, investments or other income.
- *Copies of the FAFSA worksheet can be picked up from Mrs. Renner or Mrs. Kik and used to fill out much of the information in advance. This could be especially useful if not everyone can make it. Just be sure that parents & students have pin numbers in advance, so it can be completely submitted that night.*
- **Remember, if you're going to college you need to file for financial aid (FAFSA) by March 1 to get the most, and you should file as soon as possible.**
