

Paid College Tuition for Your Student!!!



The state of Michigan has a program called the Tuition Incentive Program (TIP). It pays tuition and mandatory fees for your student if they meet the following criteria and if they contact the State of Michigan to identify themselves BEFORE graduation from high school and BEFORE they turn 20 years old. *Don't wait until the last minute; identify yourself now – even if you are not a senior this year!!!*

- Have (or have had) Medicaid coverage for 24 months within a 36-consecutive-month period between sixth and twelfth grade.
- Graduate from high school or obtain a GED prior to age 20.
- U.S. Citizen or eligible non-citizen

*Students eligible MUST complete and return the application that will be mailed to your home by the Michigan Department of Treasury.

How do you get started?

1. Call (888)447-2687 to request a copy of a letter stating eligibility and to also let them know you will be using the money.
 - You will need to give your social security number and date of birth to identify yourself and to have the letter sent to you.
2. Fax a copy of the letter (your senior year of high school) to the Financial Aid office of the college you will be attending.
3. Fax a copy of your high school diploma to the Financial Aid office in the spring.
