(2nd-4th gr.: please be sure to label all materials brought from home.)

KINDERGARTEN

- 2 packs of glue sticks
- 2 - 8 ct. Crayola Classic broad tip markers
- 2 - 4 ct. dry erase markers (low odor)
- 1 large backpack
- 4 - two pocket folders
- 2 erasers (white or pink)
- 1 - 24 ct. Crayola crayons
- 1 - 8 ct. Crayola water color paint
