#### Notes from the Office

- Please plan on students going outside for recess daily (wind chill is monitored). The up and down
  temperatures means melting snow, which can mean wet, slushy playgrounds. Please make sure
  your child has all their winter gear—snow pants, boots, extra gloves, and hats. Extra clothes are a
  great idea if they get wet at recess and need to change. We do not have extra gear for the
  students to borrow this year.
- We encourage parents to send in chapstick and reusable water bottles with their child each day. Due to allergy concerns, we do not have lip balm to offer students.
- According to district policy, cough drops are considered a medicine, therefore must be kept in the office and brought into school by an adult.
- If your phone number has changed, please update this with the school. A current, primary phone number needs to be on file for all Robocalls from the school district (snow day calls).
- Please remember to update the office if you have a change of address. A new proof of residency is needed to change your students address.
- If your student is absent, please call the office attendance line, (616) 636-5669, press 1. Absences must be reported to the office within 24 hours for it to be excused. **A reason for the students** absence must be stated or it will be considered unexcused.
- Any changes to how your student is going home for the day needs to be received by the office no later than 2:45pm to prevent further interruptions to classroom learning.

# A Message from our District Nurses!

We are excited to share that we now have a District Nurse tab on the Tri County website. This is a great resource for illness guidelines, immunization information and general information regarding the nursing services our district nurses provide students. <u>District Nurse-Tri County Area Schools</u>

The nurse's office is available to our students as an essential health resource. If your child needs to take medication during the school day, all medications need to be brought into school by an adult and a medication authorization form needs to be filled out by a parent or guardian. This includes all over-the-counter medications including cough drops. For prescription medications a physician's order is required.
