Notes from the Office

- According to district policy, cough drops are considered a medicine, therefore must be kept in the office and brought into school by an adult.

- Please remember to update the office if you have a change of address. A new proof of residency is needed to change your students address.
- If your student is absent, please call the office attendance line, (616) 636-5669, press 1. Absences must be reported to the office within 24 hours for it to be excused. **A reason for the students** absence must be stated or it will be considered unexcused.
- If you know ahead of time that your student will be absent, a planned absence form can be filled out and submitted to the office. Planned Absence Form


Our spring youth league is here for 5th,
