



# K-5 At-A-Glance Assessment Calendar\_2022-23

Content Areas: Math, Reading, Writing, Science, Social Studies

**PURPOSE:** This is an initial part of the alignment process as it relates to common assessments and data collection. By ensuring we have assessment dates documented, PLC teams will stay on pace with their curricula, will be able to look at the assessments during PLC meetings, and will be better able to meet the needs of students through whole group and small group instruction. This document will also provide an overview of content-based assessments (Math, Reading, Writing, Science, Social Studies) for each grade level. NOTE: Common pre/post assessments may be proctored no more than 3-4 days prior to the documented date. All common assessments shall be proctored by the documented date.
